SIDS is the leading cause of death for infants from one month to one year of age. In 2004 SIDS accounted for 11% of all deaths reviewed by the Franklin County Child Fatality Review Board. Too many babies are dying in unsafe sleep environments and these deaths are preventable.

This program will create awareness and educate the community about safe sleep for babies.
